HIT Implementation management

Bansal hospital is a 100 bed multi sphericality hospital at Kanpur, they have 2 more 25 bed facility in Lucknow and Benaras. The group has decided to replace the present HIS systems that they are using for last 10 years. It has tied up with a service provider who will take care of this overall implementation and support for 3 years. The estimated implementation time will be 6 months and each roll out will be of 1 month each. EMR implementation will be part of this project and will constitute a major part of the project scope. Standalone ERP and CRM needs to be implemented separately however the interfacing is part of this implementation. This new HIS will be hosted on cloud and all locations will be connected to this centralized deployment.

Some of the cost components are as follows:

- License of the software: INR 10,000 per bed per year in SAS model after Go Live
- Implementation effort : 40 man months
- Man month cost for implementation : 2 L
- Interfacing effort : 5 man months
- Roll out effort : 10 man months
- Support effort : 5 persons throughout the support duration
- Man month cost for support : 1 L
