- 6. You have been suddenly called to mortuary due to a fight between a group of relatives and mortuary supervisor. The relatives argue that the body handed over to them is not theirs.
- 7. The breakdown of the hospital's mortuary van is a routine story. This has lead to mushrooming of unauthorized transporters outside the campus wall.
